Luke 17:11-19 ¹¹“On His way to Jerusalem, Jesus went along the border between Samaria and Galilee. ¹²As He was going into a village, ten men with leprosy came toward Him. They stood at a distance ¹³and shouted, ‘Jesus, Master, have pity on us!’ ¹⁴Jesus looked at them and said, ‘Go show yourselves to the priests.’ On their way they were healed. ¹⁵When one of them discovered that he was healed, he came back, shouting praises to God. ¹⁶He bowed down at the feet of Jesus and thanked Him. The man was from the country of Samaria. ¹⁷Jesus asked, ‘Weren’t ten men healed? Where are the other nine?’ ¹⁸Why was this foreigner the only one who came back to thank God?’ ¹⁹Then Jesus told the man, ‘You may get up and go. Your faith has made you well.’” (CEV)

1. I Am Supposed To Be Closer

Luke 17:12 “As He was going into a village, ten men with leprosy came toward Him. They stood at a distance...” (CEV)

Leviticus 13:45-46 ⁴⁵“Those who suffer from a serious skin disease must tear their clothing and leave their hair uncombed. They must cover their mouth and call out, ‘Unclean! Unclean!’ ⁴⁶As long as the serious disease lasts, they will be ceremonially unclean. They must live in isolation in their place outside the camp.” (NLT)

James 4:8 “Come close to God and God will come close to you.” (NLT)

2. I Need To Cry Out

Luke 17:12b-13 ^{12b}“They stood at a distance ¹³and shouted, ‘Jesus, Master, have pity on us!’” (CEV)

Psalms 4:6 “This poor man cried out and the Lord heard him and saved him from out of all his troubles.” (NKJV)
