Luke 4:1-13 <sup>1</sup>“Then Jesus, being filled with the Holy Spirit, returned from the Jordan and was led by the Spirit into the wilderness, <sup>2</sup>being tempted for forty days by the devil. And in those days He ate nothing, and afterward, when they had ended, He was hungry. <sup>3</sup>The devil said to Him, ‘If You are the Son of God, command this stone to become bread.’ <sup>4</sup>Jesus answered him, saying, ‘It is written, ‘Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word of God.’ <sup>5</sup>The devil, taking Him up on a high mountain, showed Him all the kingdoms of the world in a moment of time. <sup>6</sup>And the devil said to Him, ‘All this authority I will give You, and their glory; for this has been delivered to me, and I give it to whomever I wish. <sup>7</sup>Therefore, if You will worship before me, all will be Yours.’ <sup>8</sup>Jesus answered and said to him, ‘Get behind Me, Satan! For it is written, ‘You shall worship the Lord your God, and Him only you shall serve.’ <sup>9</sup>The devil brought Him to Jerusalem, set Him on the pinnacle of the temple, and said to Him, ‘If You are the Son of God, throw Yourself down from here.’ <sup>10</sup>For it is written, ‘He shall give His angels charge over you, to keep you,’ <sup>11</sup>and, ‘In their hands they shall bear you up, lest you dash your foot against a stone.’ <sup>12</sup>Jesus answered and said to him, ‘It has been said, ‘You shall not tempt the Lord your God.’ <sup>13</sup>Now when the devil had ended every temptation, he departed from Him until an opportune time.” (NKJV)

Hebrews 4:15 “Jesus was tempted in every way that we are. But, He did not sin!” (CEV)

### 2. The Process

James 1:14-15 <sup>14</sup>“People are tempted when their own evil desire leads them away and traps them. <sup>15</sup>This desire leads to sin, and then the sin grows and brings death.” (NCV)



### 3. The Pain

Psalm 38:4 “I am drowning in the flood of my sins; they are a burden too heavy to bear.” (GNB)

### 4. The Power

Romans 6:16 “Don’t you realize that whatever you choose to obey becomes your master? You can choose sin, which leads to death, or you can choose to obey God and receive His approval.” (NLT)

### 5. The Penalty

Romans 6:23 “The wages of sin is death...” (NKJV)

### 6. The Prevention

1 Corinthians 10:13 “No temptation has overtaken you except such as is common to man; but God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will also make the way of escape, that you may be able to bear it.” (NKJV)

1 John 1:8-9 <sup>8</sup>“If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. <sup>9</sup>If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.” (NKJV)
